To Bring:

- Dry bags/Ziploc bags for things that need to stay dry while canoeing
- Proper clothing for canoeing and camping (i.e. NO JEANS, quick dry pants, shirts, shoes that can get wet, jacket/hoodie, etc.)

- Spend a morning, August 9th from 9:00am-11:30am, at Spring Lake Park learning safety skills and team building
- Arrive at CCCB office at 10am on August 10th for a day canoeing trip
- Return to the CCCB office at 4:00pm on August 10th for pick-up
