## Cherokee County Conservation Steven Nelson Memorial Scholarship

The Cherokee County Conservation Steven Nelson Memorial Scholarship (\$700) will be awarded annually to help a qualified student pursuing a college degree that will allow them to enter into a career in fisheries and wildlife conservation or environmental sciences. This is not a need-based scholarship.

Applications are due April 1 of each year. Applications will be screened and a recommendation made by the Cherokee County Conservation Scholarship Committee. The Board of Directors of Cherokee County Conservation will review the recommendation. If no applicants are qualified, the scholarship will not be awarded.

The scholarship will be awarded/presented by the chairperson or designee of the Board of Directors of Cherokee County Conservation at the May Conservation Board meeting.

Eligibility criteria for the scholarship are as follows:

- 1. Student of MMCRU or Washington High School
- 2. A high school senior in good standing with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- 3. Pursuing a degree in fisheries and wildlife conservation or environmental sciences.
- 4. ACT score of 20 or above.
- 5. Preference will be given to applicants who demonstrate hands-on experience in local conservation.
