

Licklider Shooting Complex

Request For Proposals
Due: 1/5/2024 by noon

Cherokee County Conservation Board (CCCB) is accepting proposals to furnish the Board with necessary labor and materials, except as provided by the Board, for the construction of a trap shooting area with four fields and houses located at the Licklider Shooting Complex, 5949 Little Sioux Road, Cherokee, IA. These fields will provide an area for local school shooting teams to practice and to compete. Open shoots will be scheduled for the general public during non-practice or competition times.

Construction plans will follow the specifications of the trap field and house diagram recommended by the Amateur Trap Association (ATA) and provided by Golden West Industries. A copy of the plans with specifications can be obtained by contacting Laura Jones at the CCCB Office, 629 River Rd, Cherokee, IA or by visiting www.cherokeecountyparks.com.

The project includes layout, construction, and installation of approximately four trap fields with concrete lanes and one in ground pitted trap house per field. Fields and house are to be built per plans and specifications, except that the house will be made from slab concrete a minimum of 6" thick with rebar every 24". A connecting walkway must be completed to connect the four fields. Concrete lanes and walkway must be limestone, a minimum of 4" thick, and have a 1" gravel or crushed concrete base. Numbers must be stamped in each lane. The first house is approximately 130 ft east from the road and each house is 90 ft apart, center-to-center. No lights, no fence. Minor grading work may need to be done by contractor in order to complete above work.

The CCCB is responsible for having the trap field area cleared and graded prior to the construction of the four fields. The CCCB is also responsible for providing an electrician to trench electrical prior to the concrete being poured, but after the fields are laid out.

The CCCB has the ability to assist by providing staff exclusively to the installation of this project in order assist with work like installing and removing concrete forms as well as smoothing poured concrete. It must be listed in the proposal if there's potential for CCCB staff to be needed for this project.

Proposals must be detailed as to the work to be performed to enable completion of the trap area project according to plans and specifications. Include proposed start and completion dates. Include company name, representative, address and phone numbers.

Funds for this project will be collected from grants, local fundraising, and through the CCCB's budget. Fundraising will include giving donors naming rights to a field for the cost of field installation. The Board would like this project to be completed by September 30, 2024. Area will be ready for field construction by May 31, 2024.

All proposals are due by noon CT Friday, January 5, 2024 at the CCCB, 629 River Road, Cherokee, Iowa 51012. Proposals will be reviewed by the Board at their meeting on Monday, January 8, 2024.
