

## **LICKLIDER SHOOTING COMPLEX RULES**

Range fees must be paid prior to use of facilities.

All shooters and guests must sign-in at the registration station BEFORE commencing use of the range

When range is full, please limit open shooting to 1 hour to allow other shooters use of the facilities.

All minors must be under direct supervision of a responsible adult.

Alcohol, illegal drugs, and all those under the influence are prohibited from the range and surrounding area.

All shooting must take place at the appropriate range location.

Range hours are sunrise to sunset. The range is closed December 23-March 1, weather dependent.

No hunting or camping on the property.

Abuse of property or illegal dumping will result in range closure.

Any violation of these rules may result in a citation and/or revocation of range privileges.

## **GUN RANGE RULES**

Always keep firearms pointed in a safe direction.

Always keep guns unloaded with actions open and in racks, cased, or holstered unless at the firing line preparing to shoot.

Firearms must be aimed and fired deliberately (no shooting from the hip, etc.) at the berm. No shooting at the ground or objects on the ground. No indiscriminate or "blue sky" shooting is allowed.

No person is allowed down range until shooting has stopped and the range is made safe. Communicated with others before going down range to change/set targets.

Do not handle firearms while others are down range.

Guns must be unloaded with actions open and safeties on when others are down range. Do not handle firearms while others are down range.

Paper targets only placed on the target holders. Explosive targets like Tannerite are prohibited.

Eye and ear protection is required.

Shooting is limited to legal firearms only. No modern center fire rifle caliber .50 or larger may be fired.

Fully automatic firearms, armor piercing ammunition, steel core, incendiary, chemical, tracer rounds, and the like are prohibited. No paintball guns.

Please place all used targets, trash, brass, and empty shotgun shells in receptacles provided. Live ammunition may not go into those receptacles.

Any violation of these rules may result in a citation and/or revocation of range privileges.

### **ARCHERY RANGE RULES**

Archery area is open from April-November.

Field points only, NO BROADHEADS.

No arrow outserts.

No person is allowed down range until shooting has stopped and the range is made safe. Communicated with others before going down range.

Arrows must be shot from designated shooting line only.

Keep arrows pointed down or towards the target in front of you. No sky draws or shooting across lanes.

No firearms, air guns, throwing knives, or hatchets.

Crossbows can only be used on the designated target.

Any violation of these rules may result in a citation and/or revocation of range privileges.

### **TRAP FIELDS RULES**

Always keep firearms pointed in a safe direction.

Always keep guns unloaded with actions open and in racks, cased, or holstered unless at the firing line preparing to shoot.

Firearms must be aimed and fired deliberately (no shooting from the hip, etc.) at the berm. No shooting at the ground or objects on the ground. No indiscriminate or "blue sky" shooting is allowed.

No person is allowed down range to load targets until shooting has stopped and the range is made safe. Communicated with others before going down range to change/set targets.

Do not handle firearms while others are down range.

Guns must be unloaded with actions open and safeties on when others are down range. Do not handle firearms while others are down range.

Eye and ear protection is required.

Shooting is limited to legal firearms only.

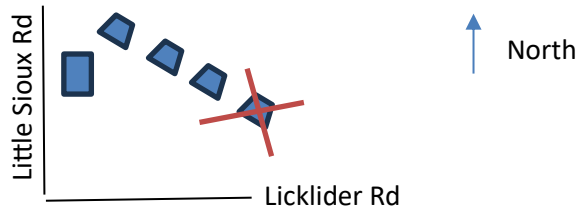
Clay pigeon targets only. No other targets may be used in this area.

Additional fees will apply for purchasing clay pigeons.

When staff is not available to run machines, they are closed to public use; however, you may bring in your own clay pigeons and throwing machines, throwing targets in appropriate direction.

Personal machines may not be used when range machines are operating.

Eastern most trap field cannot be used without CCCB staff present to close the gun range.



Shooters are to use designated shooting lanes and stations provided, shooting only at clay pigeons thrown in the appropriate direction from the trap houses.

Maximum shot size 1 1/8 oz, 7.5 shot, 3 dram load. No Buckshot or slugs.

Shooters are responsible for picking up their spent shotgun shells.

Any violation of these rules may result in a citation and/or revocation of range privileges.
